Databases & Indexes

NOTE: When full-text is not available from one of the Library's databases, please use our Interlibrary Loan (ILL) service to obtain materials from other institutions. ILL forms are available from the Library Reference Desk. Please allow up to two weeks for delivery of ILL items.

Subject Specific Databases

- **PsycARTICLES** (Journals@Ovid)
Database of full-text articles from journals published by the American Psychological Association, the APA Educational Publishing Foundation, the Canadian Psychological Association, and Hogrefe Publishing Group, covering academic, research, and practice literature in psychology and related disciplines
- **PsycINFO** (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases Page)
From the American Psychological Association (APA), PsycINFO is the largest resource devoted to peer-reviewed literature in behavioral science and mental health. It contains abstracts of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertations. Journal coverage, which spans from 1887 to present, includes international material selected from more than 2,200 periodicals in more than 27 languages.

- **Health and Psychosocial Instruments (HaPI)**
Produced by Behavioral Measurement Database Services, HaPI is a comprehensive bibliographic database providing information about behavioral measurement instruments. Information in the database is abstracted from hundreds of leading journals covering health sciences and psychosocial sciences. Additionally, instruments from Industrial/Organizational Behavior and Education are included. Records contained in HaPI provide information on questionnaires, interview schedules, vignettes/scenarios, coding schemes, rating and other scales, checklists, indexes, tests, projective techniques, and more.
- **JSTOR** (available from the Library's Databases page)
Interdisciplinary, searchable, full-text archive of almost 1,000 academic journals covering the humanities, social sciences, and life sciences. Journals are always included from volume 1, issue 1 and include previous and related titles. The most recently published issues (past 3-5 years) are not available. However, users can search this material and link to the publisher's site or other online source for access. New content is added on a regular basis as it is made available by the publisher. Advanced search options include author name, title, abstract, and caption for photographs and other images.
- **Wiley InterScience** (available from the Library's Databases page)
Online collection of books and journals covering scientific, technical, medical, and scholarly content

Related Area Databases

- **Academic Search Premier** (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)
A multi-disciplinary full text database containing full text for more than 4,500 journals, including more than 3,700 peer-reviewed titles.
- **ACCESS/SCIENCE**
Fully searchable content of over 8,500 articles from McGraw-Hill's Encyclopedia of Science & Technology, 10th Edition providing access to authoritative articles in all major areas of science and technology. Additional content includes research updates from the *McGraw-Hill Yearbooks of Science & Technology*, definitions from the *McGraw-Hill Dictionary of Scientific and Technical Terms*, and 15,000 illustrations and graphics, and bibliographies containing more than 28,000 literature citations, and video, illustrations, animations, and image galleries.
- **Cambridge Scientific Abstracts - Sociological Abstracts**
(available from the Library's Databases page)
CSA Sociological Abstracts abstracts and indexes the international literature in sociology and related disciplines in the social and behavioral sciences. The database provides abstracts of journal articles and citations to book reviews drawn from over 1,800+ serials publications, and also provides abstracts of books, book chapters, dissertations, and conference papers.

- **CINAHL** (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases Page)
The Cumulative Index to Nursing and Allied Health Literature (CINAHL) is a comprehensive source of full text for nursing and allied health journals, providing full text for more than 600 journals. Full-text coverage dates back to 1981.
- **ERIC (Education Resources Information Center)** (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)
Database of journal articles and other education-related materials including books, research syntheses, conference reports, technical reports, and policy papers from scholarly organizations, professional associations, research centers, policy organizations, university presses, the U.S. Department of Education and other federal agencies, and state and local agencies.

- **Health Source: Nursing/Academic Edition**
Provides nearly 550 scholarly full text journals focusing on many medical disciplines. Also includes drug information.
- **MasterFile Premier**
This multidisciplinary database provides full text for nearly 1,750 general reference publications with full text information dating as far back as 1975, including 500 full text reference books, biographies, full text primary source documents, and an Image Collection of photos, maps and flags.
- **NetLibrary** (via NC LIVE; available from the Library's Databases page)
Provides searchable full-text access to eBooks and eAudiobooks and other eContent. Covers psychology and related disciplines.
- **PubMed** (<http://pubmed.gov>)
The National Library of Medicine's premier database of journal citations for the life sciences with a concentration on biomedicine. Covers 1950 – present.
The Abridged Index Medicus is available in print in the Reference Area.

- **SpringerLink**
Database of *selected* full-text journals in a variety of subject areas including humanities, social sciences and law, and behavioral science. (NOTE: Full-text access to reference materials and e-books is NOT available. Full-text access to the most recent 3 – 6 months of journals may also be restricted.)
