Dear applicant and future Belmont Abbey student:

I am pleased that you are interested in this outstanding program. The Hintemeyer program is designed to foster the leadership potential of a select group of Catholic men and women. The program requires exemplary character; serious commitment to the truth and life of Catholicism; exceptionally strong self-motivation, initiative, and creativity; academic diligence and accomplishment; and employment of these qualities and abilities in the service of others.

Throughout their four years in the program, Hintemeyer scholars strive to grow together in faith, virtue, and knowledge, and to discern through reflection and practice the nature of authentic Catholic leadership. Central to each participant's experience will be seminars on a variety of leadership and faith topics, communal prayer and participation in the sacraments, and regular student-generated service and leadership activities on and off campus, culminating junior year in a large-scale project of the student's own design.

The Hintemeyer program is seeking students who live their faith with conviction, who have proven leadership ability and self-motivation, and who have a desire to serve others. Please read carefully the requirements and instructions listed below. Incomplete or unqualified applications will not be considered.

In addition to filling out the application form, we ask that you write a 1000 word essay explaining the relationship between your faith and your leadership experience and aspirations. If possible, you should highlight an experience that connected your leadership with your faith.

There are three recommendation forms that must be completed and sent directly to the admissions office by your recommenders. You must fill out the top portion and then give them to your recommenders. Please give one to your pastor or parochial vicar, one to an employer, volunteer supervisor, or coach, and one to your youth minister or mentor, for a total of three recommendations. Please do not send more than three recommendations as only the first three will be considered. Recommendations from relatives will not be accepted.

Once you have submitted all application materials you will be contacted and informed of finalist status. All scholarship finalists will be invited to scholarship weekend, February 17–18, 2012, in order to get to know current Hintemeyer students and learn more about the program, to experience campus life, and to interview with a scholarship committee. Instructions and Qualifications:

In order to meet the minimum qualifications and be considered for the Hintemeyer Scholarship you must:

- Be accepted to Belmont Abbey College
- Have a minimum 3.5 (un-weighted) high school GPA and a 1200 SAT score* (**Verbal & Math only**)
- Complete the Hintemeyer Scholarship application and submit on or before January 27, 2012
- Have all recommendation forms submitted directly from your recommenders no later than January 27, 2012. Belmont Abbey College attn Admissions/Scholarship 100 Belmont Mt Holly Rd, Belmont NC 28012
- Have proven leadership ability and a history of service to others
- Only apply for *either* the Honors Fellowship *or* the Hintemeyer Scholarship—no student may apply for both scholarships.
- If selected as a finalist, attend scholarship weekend February 17–18, 2012

* If your GPA or test scores are below the stated minimum, but you feel that those numbers do not accurately reflect your academic ability, you may contact program director Patrick Ford directly at 704-461-6545 or patrickford@bac.edu. Exceptions will be extremely rare and made according to director's judgment only. Do not contact Admissions with questions on this issue.
